AGENDA:

1. INTRODUCTION

The President of AIUA; Prof. Dr. K.H. Yudian Wahyudi, opened the meeting by welcoming all delegates to Perlis, Malaysia and proceeded with the recitation of Surah al-Fatihah.

2. WELCOMING REMARKS FROM THE HOST UNIVERSITY, BY THE RECTOR OF KOLEJ UNIVERSITI ISLAM PERLIS (KUIPs), PERLIS, MALAYSIA

2.1 Assoc. Prof. Dr. Mohd Mizan Mohammad Aslam, the Rector of Kolej Universiti Islam Perlis (KUIPs) expressed his thanks and welcomed all delegates to Perlis, Malaysia for the 7th AIUA Meeting. He bid for the meeting to run smoothly and apologized for any shortcomings.

2.2 Three prearranged events were held during the 7th AIUA Meeting;

1) Cycling

2) Dinner with DYTm Chancellor of KUIPs and

3) International Conference on Deradicalization (ICOD)

2.3 He then conveyed the regards from Duli Yang Teramat Mulia Tuanku Syed Faizuddin Putra Ibni Tuanku Syed Sirajuddin Jamalullail; KUIPs Chancellor to all AIUA members. His Highness hoped that AIUA will become a platform to strengthen the relationship with regional and international bodies, and to keep member institutions informed about educational developments in the region.

3. INTRODUCTION OF NEW AIUA MEMBERS

3.1 The meeting received numerous application proposals from regional institutions to join as new members of AIUA. The AIUA constitution stated that only the AIUA founding members have the right to vote, approve and accept new AIUA member applications. The AIUA founding institutions in attendance were as following:

- vii. Kolej Universiti Islam Perlis (KUIPs),
- viii. Kolej Universiti Islam Pahang Sultan Ahmad Shah (KUIPSAS),
- ix. Kolej Universiti Islam Melaka (KUIM),
- x. Kolej Universiti Islam Antarabangsa Selangor (KUIS), and
- xi. International Islamic College (IIC).

3.2 The meeting received motions from:

- i. Kolej Universiti Islam Antarabangsa Selangor (KUIS) for Institut Profesional Baitulmal (IPB) to be accepted as a new AIUA member.
- ii. Universitas Islam Negeri (UIN) Sunan Kalijaga for Universitas Islam Negeri (UIN) Sumatera Utara and Universitas Islam Negeri (UIN) Raden Fatah Palembang to be accepted as new AIUA members.

- 3.3 The AIUA founders accepted the motion by Kolej Universiti Islam Antarabangsa Selangor (KUIS) and Universitas Islam Negeri (UIN) Sunan Kalijaga.
- 3.4 The meeting unanimously endorsed and approved Institut Profesional Baitulmal (IPB), Universitas Islam Negeri (UIN) Sumatera Utara and Universitas Islam Negeri (UIN) Raden Fatah Palembang as new AIUA members. As of the 15th of March 2018, the total number of AIUA member institutions are 62 (See Appendix A).
- 3.5 The new members need to complete the Registration Form and pay the lifetime membership fee payment of USD500.00 to the AIUA account.

4. OPENING SPEECH BY THE PRESIDENT OF AIUA

- 4.1 Prof. Dr. K.H. Yudian Wahyudi, the current President of AIUA expressed his thanks and gratitude to the AIUA delegates from Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand and Brunei for their attendance in the meeting. The President then expressed his thanks to Kolej Universiti Islam Perlis (KUIPs) for hosting the 7th AIUA Meeting. He also expressed the importance of AIUA:
- i. To have a good Quality Assurance Guidelines,
 - ii. To have a strong Corporate Business base and foundation,
 - iii. To have good inter-university programmes,
 - iv. To explore new areas for AIUA journal (i.e. in International Islamic Banking, Law, Education and Philosophy), and
 - v. To encourage more institutions to participate and become AIUA members.

The President started the meeting by first reviewing the agenda of the meeting; as of the following:

- ii. Matters arising from the previous meeting – Reports on the AIUA Strategic Plan Guidelines by the respective committees:
 - a. The Joint Degree Division Committee – UIN Sunan Ampel

 - c. The Business Economic Partner Division Committee – UNISSA
 - d. The Knowledge Dissemination Division Committee – UIN Antasari
 - e. The Joint Award Division Committee – IAIN Kendari
 - f. The Student Exchange Division Committee – KUIPs
- iii. AIUA Financial Report.
- iv. Other matters.
- v. Decision on the date, venue and host for the next AIUA meeting.

4.2 The President reminded all AIUA members of their commitments and responsibilities towards the lifetime membership fee payment of USD500.00 to the AIUA account.

5. APPROVAL OF THE PREVIOUS MINUTES

5.1 The meeting unanimously endorsed and approved the 6th AIUA Meeting Minutes.

6. MATTERS ARISING

6.1 Presentation of Asian Islamic Universities Association (AIUA) Strategic Plan Guidelines

Note: Respective Guidelines had been presented during the Workshop dated on the 12th to 14th March 2018 in Pattani province, Thailand.

i. Joint Degree Division Committee

(Universitas Islam Negeri (UIN) Sunan Ampel, Surabaya, Indonesia)

Report and feedback(s):

No report was presented.

ii. Joint Research Division Committee

(Institut Agama Islam Negeri (IAIN) Palopo, South Sulawesi, Indonesia)

Report and feedback(s):

- a. The Joint Research committee needs to revise the guideline's language structure, terms and diction.
- b. The Guideline needs to be further revised before being endorsed and published.

iii. Business Economic Partner Division Committee

(Universiti Islam Sultan Sharif Ali (UNISSA), Brunei)

Report and feedback(s):

- a. AIUA needs to establish a company to conduct business plans

- b. AIUA members need to determine the most suitable region to establish a company (i.e. in Malaysia/ Brunei/ Indonesia) based on the country's legal systems.
- c. AIUA members need to propose the sources of the business capital, for example:
 - i. From AIUA lifetime membership fee,
 - ii. From AIUA annual membership fee, and
 - iii. From AIUA conference revenue.
- d. AIUA needs to achieve the above target in 2018-2019.
- e. The Guideline needs to be further revised before being endorsed and published.

iv. Knowledge Dissemination Division Committee

(Universitas Islam Negeri (UIN) Antasari, Banjarmasin, Indonesia)

Report and feedback(s):

- a. The committee needs to revise on the guideline's language structure, terms and diction.
- b. The committee needs to include publication criterion for future reference.
- c. The ideas suggested need to be incorporated into rules and regulations.
- d. The Guideline needs to be further revised before being endorsed and published.

v. Joint Award Division Committee

(Institut Agama Islam Negeri (IAIN) Kendari, South East Sulawesi, Indonesia)

Report and feedback(s):

No report was presented.

vi. Student Exchange Division Committee

(Kolej Universiti Islam Perlis (KUIPs), Perlis, Malaysia)

Report and feedback(s):

- a. The first student exchange program (inbound) will commence in Perlis and Langkawi Island, Malaysia from the 5th of August 2018 till the 11th of August 2018.
- b. The short term programs can be held for one semester, while the long term programs can be held based on two years + one year (2 +1) twinning program format.
- c. All AIUA members need to update their institutions' curriculum on the AIUA website.
- d. The credit system for student exchange programs that should be considered:
 - i. Credited or non-credited programs
 - ii. Transferable or non-transferable credit programs.
- e. The committee needs to go through the guidelines again to revise the implementation procedure.

f. The meeting unanimously endorsed the Student Exchange Guidelines with amendment.

vii. AIUA Quality Assurance Council Committee

(Universitas Islam Negeri (UIN) Syarif Hidayatullah, Jakarta, Indonesia)

Revised and completed Guideline was presented.

Report and feedback(s):

- a. The committee should discuss the rules and regulations, the diversity of policies, as well as the university's or country's education standards and concepts of every member institutions (i.e. Indonesia, Malaysia, Brunei, and Thailand).
- b. There is a need for AIUA-QA secretariat to manage the guidelines.
- c. There is a need to revise the Training of Trainers (TOT) and AIUA-QA Guidelines in terms of:
 - i. The appointment of distinguished academic staff to be the quality assurance auditor;
 - ii. The assessment criterion which implement Islamic values in respective academic matters.
 - iii. The eligibility criterion and accreditation concept
- d. The meeting agreed that the Islamic values included in the assessment criterion will attract more Islamic institutions like Prince of Songkla University, Thailand to join AIUA.

- e. Universitas Islam Negeri (UIN) Sunan Kalijaga Yogyakarta, Yogyakarta, Indonesia; Universiti Sultan Azlan Shah (USAS), Malaysia; Fatoni University, Thailand; and Universiti Islam Sultan Sharif Ali (UNISSA), Brunei volunteered to be the pioneers for the accreditation assessments.
- f. The Guideline will be further revised in the next AIUA workshop before being endorsed in the next AIUA meeting.

6.2 Feedback From The Secretary-General

The Secretary-General urged the AIUA members to take the AIUA Strategic Plan Guidelines as a matter of high importance, and suggested for the committee members to review the following matters in regard to the drafted Guidelines:

- i. To revise and check the language usage and structure in every guidelines.
7. To include not only programs, but also a complete implementation procedures for every standard and guidelines **AIUA FINANCIAL REPORT.**

7.1 AIUA financial reports were presented by the AIUA Treasurer (Universiti Islam Sultan Sharif Ali, Brunei).

Feedback: Universitas Islam Negeri (UIN) Sunan Kalijaga Yogyakarta suggested that AIUA need to take the operating cost into account as expenditure.

8. OTHER MATTERS

- 8.1 The meeting suggested that all AIUA institutions need to have their own internal AIUA secretariat.
- 8.2 The meeting suggested that the Guidelines should be translated into English language towards the internationalization of AIUA.
- 8.3 The meeting suggested that the AIUA Quality Assurance secretariat will be changed from Universitas Islam Negeri (UIN) Syarif Hidayatullah, Jakarta, Indonesia (currently) to Universitas Islam Negeri (UIN) Sunan Kalijaga Yogyakarta, Yogyakarta, Indonesia.
- 8.4 The meeting suggested that the next AIUA workshop on the 1st and 2nd July 2018 will be focusing on the Training of Trainers (TOT) for accreditation assessment.

9. MEETING ADJOURNED

- 9.1 The meeting concurred that the 8th AIUA Meeting and AIUA Quality Assurance workshop will be held at Universitas Islam Negeri (UIN) Sunan Kalijaga, Yogyakarta, Indonesia from the 2nd of July to the 5th of July 2018.
- 9.2 The meeting was adjourned at 5.30pm.
